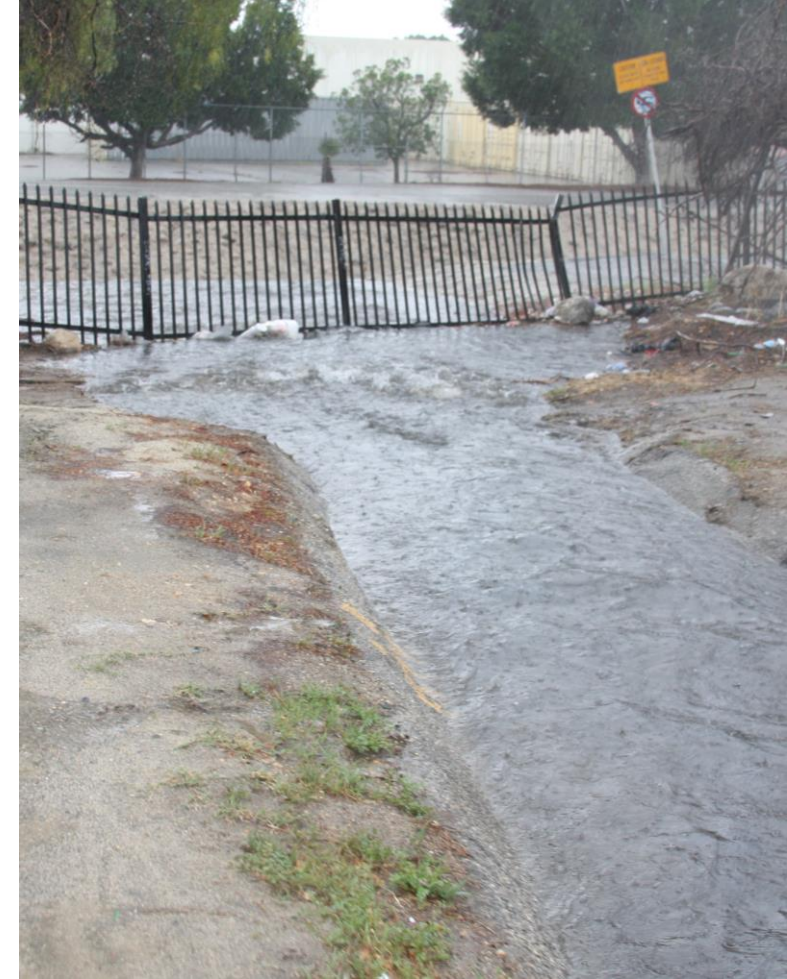

Reimagine Your River, Creeks, and Streams



- Evaluates conditions of the waterways
- Identifies improvements to the tributaries and LA River
- Addresses topics such as:

 - Health
 - Mobility
 - Resource Conservation
 - Habitat
 - Water
 - Safety
 - Recreation

ULART Working Group

- Comprised of local agency representatives, ranging from local elected officials, community leaders, and non-profit organizations from throughout the Upper LA River watershed
- Influences watershed-based planning methods
- Directed by State legislation, established late 2018
- Supported by Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy

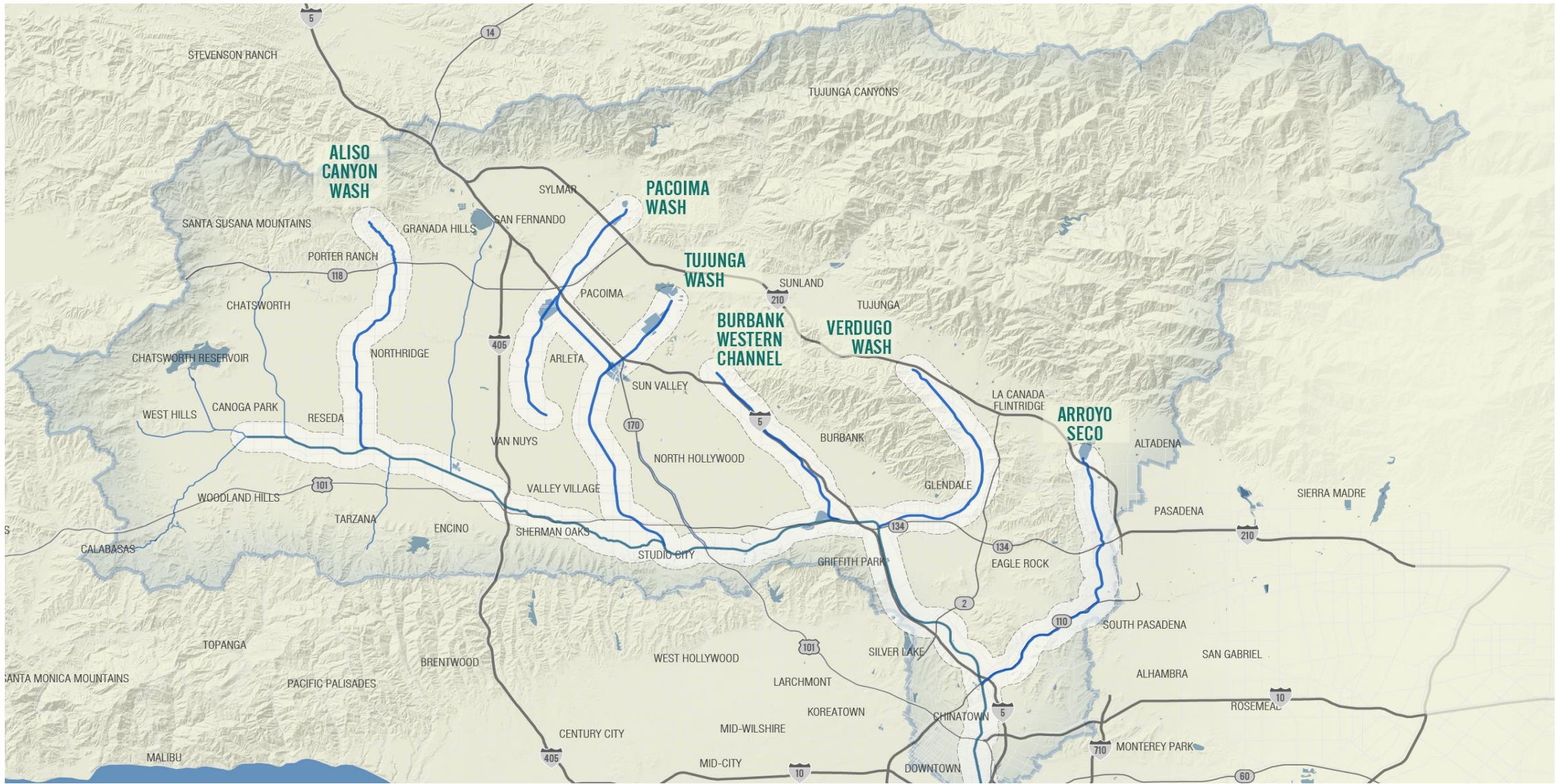
Reimagine Your River, Creeks, and Streams

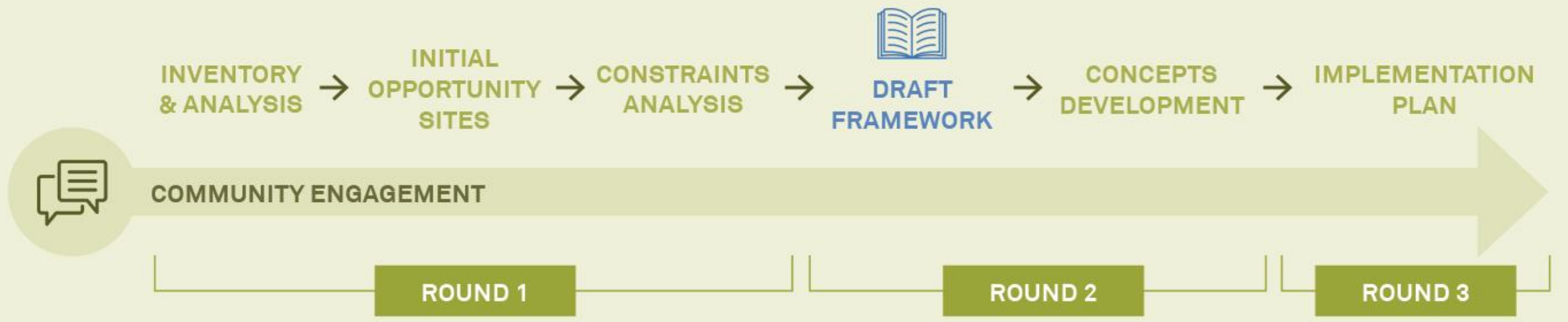
